

Public Information: **ABSENTEE VOTING FOR REGISTERED VOTERS:**

General Election will be held on November 2, 2010. Polls will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

**IN PERSON:** For persons who would like to vote by means of Absentee Ballot, they may do so in person at the Latah County Auditor's office, Room 101 of the Latah County Courthouse, 522 South Adams, **through Friday October 29, 2010 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.** [NEW!-This will be the Friday before the election.] They will be asked to complete a written Application for Absent Elector's Ballot **and must show picture ID or sign a Personal Identification Affidavit before voting.** (Sec. 34-1113 and Sec. 34-1114, Idaho Code) [New!]

**BY MAIL:** Written request for absentee ballot to be mailed to Elector may be achieved by Elector sending a written request to the Auditor's Office asking that an absentee ballot be mailed to them. All requests must include their Latah County home address, address where they want ballot mailed, name, and date. **(All requests must be signed)** Auditor must receive a separate written request for each person making a request. Written requests should be mailed to Elections Department, P.O. Box 8068, Moscow, Idaho 83843. Written requests sent by mail must be **received in the Latah County Auditor's Office Room 101 no later than Wednesday, October 27, 2010.** [Note; Ballots for Military and Overseas electors are required by law to be mailed no later than *September 17, 2010.*] All ballots must be received by the County Clerk no later than **8:00 o'clock p.m. November 2, 2010.**
