NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that in accordance with the Help America Vote Act of 2002, each of the polling places is accessible to individuals with disabilities.

In order to vote at this election each voter must meet the following requirements:

1. Must be 18 years of age;
2. Must be a citizen of the United States;
3. Must be a bona fide resident of Latah County or Nez Perce County for thirty (30) days preceding the next election; **and must be a resident of the Genesee Joint School District No. 282.**
4. Must be properly registered or meet requirements for Election Day Registration.

***IN ADDITION TO BEING REGISTERED: Picture ID is now required to vote at the polls on Election Day or for absentee voting in person. If you do not have acceptable photo identification you must sign a Personal Identification Affidavit at the time you vote at your polling place in order to receive a ballot.***

Polls will be open from **8:00 A.M. until 8:00 P.M.**
