FEE SCHEDULE OF THE LATAH COUNTY PLANNING DEPARTMENT

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF LATAH COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
REPEALING RESOLUTION # 94-12 AND ADOPTING A FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE
COUNTY PLANNING DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Latah County, State of Idaho is the duly elected governing body of Latah County, a political subdivision of the State of Idaho, having such powers and duties as are set forth in the Constitution and Statutes of the State of Idaho; and

WHEREAS, Section 13.17 of the Latah County Zoning Ordinance (Ordinance #29 and all subsequent amendments thereto) authorizes the Board to adopt a fee schedule which reflects changes in the costs of administration of the Planning Department; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has shown that the costs of administration have changed since the October 1, 1994 fee schedule and that the fees proposed are reasonable for the processing of zoning and subdivisions applications; and

WHEREAS, the Board held a duly noticed public hearing on the proposed fee schedule on Wednesday August 14, 2002;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Latah County Commissioners of Latah County, State of Idaho, pursuant to Latah County Zoning Ordinance (Ordinance #29 and all subsequent amendments thereto), section 13.17, that:

1. The Board repeal Resolution #94-12; and
2. The Board adopt the following fee schedule:


Co-location Application	\$50.00
Variance	\$150.00
Comprehensive Plan Amendment	\$200.00
Conditional Use Permit	\$200.00
Land Division	\$100.00 plus \$25.00 for each additional lot
Planned Unit Development	\$200.00
Subdivision (Full Plat)	\$500.00
Subdivision (Short Plat)	\$250.00
Rezone	\$300.00
Zoning Ordinance Amendment	\$200.00
Appeals	\$100.00
Vacations	\$150.00
Floodplain Development Permit	\$25.00
Rural Addressing	\$25.00
Status Inspection	\$50.00

3. This resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
