NEW REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTERING A BOAT IN IDAHO THIS YEAR

Are you registering a boat in Idaho in 2017? If so, the Latah County DMV is reminding boat owners that there are new Coast Guard regulations that now apply to all Idaho boat registrations.

Effective in 2017 all HIN #'s (Hull Identification Numbers) and unique owner identification must be verified.

If you received your 2017 Idaho renewal notice from Idaho Parks & Recreation then all necessary information is already in the state system, and you only need to bring your renewal notice in with you to renew.

If you did not receive a 2017 renewal notice, you will need to do the following: Take a photo of and bring in the picture of the Hull Identification Number of your boat and your Idaho Coast Guard Number. The Hull Identification Number is typically located on the right rear of a boat. Unique owner identification is typically an Idaho driver license and date of birth for Idaho residents, or out-of-state driver license and social security number.

Owners who have questions about registering their boats in Idaho or renewing their Idaho boat registration can call Idaho Parks & Recreation at 800-247-6332, or the Latah County DMV at 208-883-7211. Latah County DMV is open Monday through Friday from 8:30AM to 5:00PM at the Latah County Annex located at 200 S Almon Street in Moscow.

Latah County DMV urges boat owners to plan ahead, and not to wait until hitched up and headed to the lake only to find out that missing documentation means they cannot get their boat registered.
