NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN: THAT the Consolidated Elections in Latah County, for the cities and fire district will be held on **Tuesday, the 7th day of November, 2017**. The polls will be open from **8:00 A.M. until 8:00 P.M. for the elections listed:**

ONLY THOSE ELECTIONS THAT THE ELECTOR IS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE IN WILL APPEAR ON THEIR BALLOT. To be eligible to vote the elector must reside in the individual city limits or in the fire district.

**Note: Pursuant to Idaho Code 34-308 the electors in this precinct will have their ballot mailed to them prior to Election Day. They will be responsible to return their ballot by 8:00 p.m. on Election Day, November 7, 2017. Persons residing in the "new" Onaway 37 precinct can complete Election Day Registration and vote on Election Day at the Latah County Auditor's Office, Room 101 of the Latah County Courthouse.*

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that in accordance with the Help America Vote Act, each of the polling places is accessible to individuals with disabilities.

In order to vote at this election each voter must meet the following requirements:

1. Must be 18 years of age;
2. Must be a citizen of the United States;
3. Must be a bona fide resident of the county **and the city or district associated with the individual election** for thirty (30) days preceding the next election;
4. Must be properly registered or meet requirements for Election Day Registration.

IN ADDITION TO BEING REGISTERED: Picture ID is required to vote at the polls on Election Day or for absentee voting in person or sign a Personal Identification Affidavit in order to receive a ballot.
